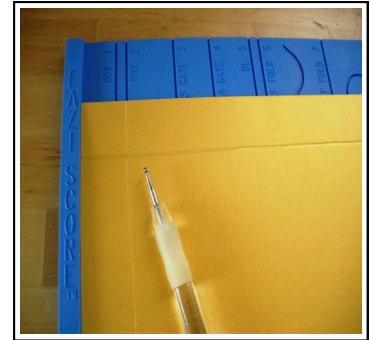
Make a
Stationary/Notelet Box packed

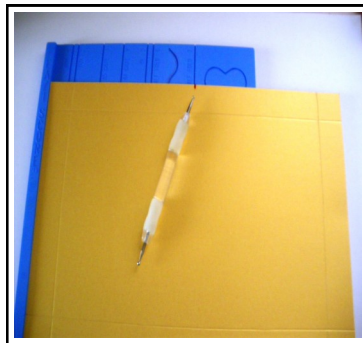


notelet ['nəʊtlɪt] *n* a folded card with a printed design on the front, for writing a short informal letter

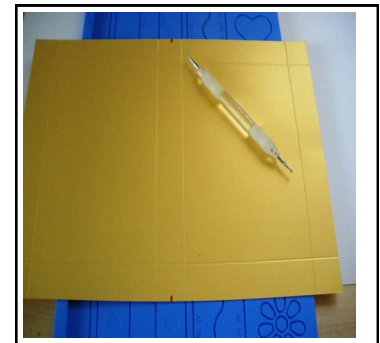
This little box is perfect for many occasions. Just right for birthday invitations, a pretty thank you note, just to say 'hello how are you' in fact these little cards are right when just a few words will do..



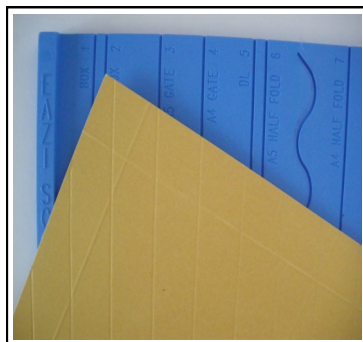
For the notelet box you will need 1 piece of A4 card in the colour of your choice. You do not need to cut or trim your card. Simply place the edge of A4 card to guide bar of Eazi-score board and score line number 2 (box 2) on each side. .



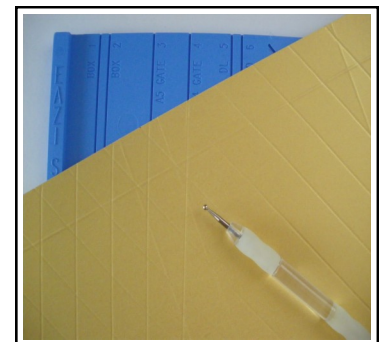
Place short edge of A4 card to guide bar mark centre top and bottom with an embossing Tool. *(I have marked with a pen so it is more visible for the photograph)*



Line this mark in the centre of lines 4 and 5—emboss both of these to the base of your A4 card.



Creating a grid pattern - Place card at an angle and score line nos. 3 and 4. move scored line 4 to 3 and score line 4 again. Repeat to end.



Create Diamond - Tilt card on to opposite angle - once again score line numbers 3 and 4 repeat to end of card
